



# Canteen Policy

## 1. STATEMENT OF BELIEF

Warragul Regional College believes that the College Canteen should provide service to the school community that is nutritious, hygienically prepared and is sustainably sourced in accordance with the Go for your life 'Healthy Canteen Kit'. The Canteen should also be an operation which encourages participation from the school community.

## 2. OBJECTIVES

**Those responsible for the Canteen aim to:**

- 2.1 Encourage healthy eating habits and positively influence student's awareness and knowledge of 'nutritious' food.
- 2.2 Continue to improve the nutritional value of food available.
- 2.3 Cater for a variety of food tastes, budgets and special, known dietary needs.
- 2.4 Support students' and the college community to become involved in assisting in the Canteen's operation.
- 2.5 Involve student and adults in the planning and marketing of the Canteen services and continue to source sustainable, eco-friendly packaging and food.

## 3. IMPLEMENTATION

- 3.1 The College Council is responsible for the Canteen and its policies.
- 3.2 The Canteen shall operate within the DEECD, State and Local Government laws/regulations/guidelines. The 'Go for your life' Healthy Canteen Kit- Food Planner and the School Canteens and other School Food Services Policy which should be supplied across the whole school environment.
- 3.3 The Canteen Manager shall report regularly to the College's Finance Committee.
- 3.4 The Canteen Manager will change the menu in accordance with the "Go for your life" program and the "Heart Smart" recommendations in consultation with students.
- 3.5 The Canteen Manager is responsible for: setting prices; supervising Canteen staff and volunteers; managing the Canteen budget.

## 4. EVALUATION

This policy was last updated in March 2019 and will be reviewed in four years' time as part of the review cycle.
