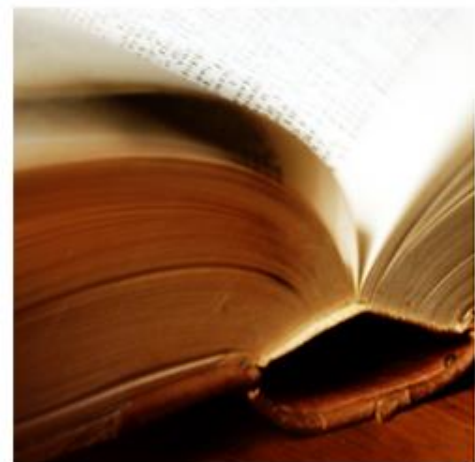

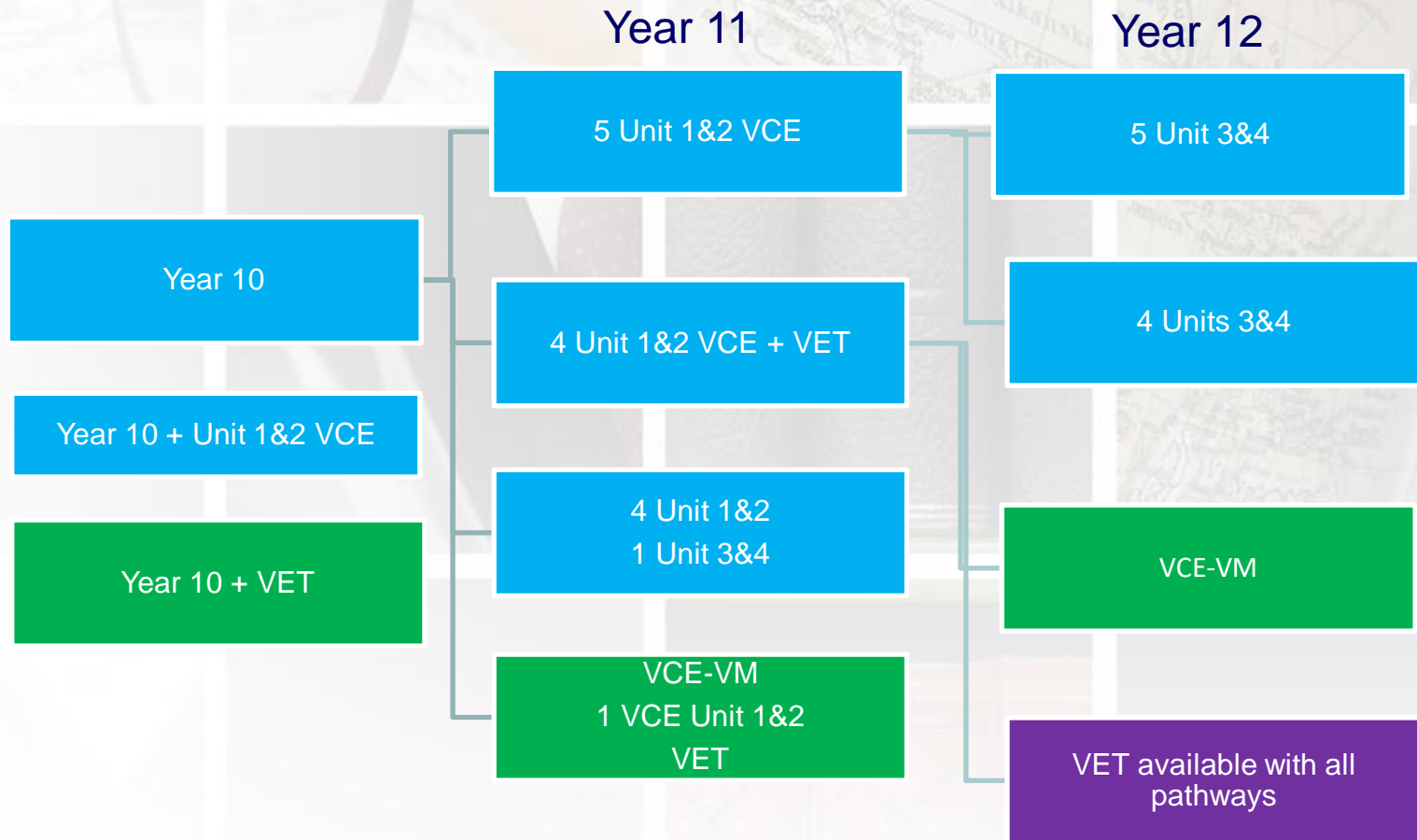

VETDSS (Vocational Education and Training)

- WRC offers students access to a wide variety of VET courses which appeal to different interests and career pathways.
- VET programs can combine with either VCE or VCE VM and provide the opportunity to get experience in the workplace.
- VET certificates take 1 or 2 years to complete.
- VET courses are delivered in partnership with other schools and training providers.
