- Testing, fixing and securing electrical equipment

On completion, if you choose to continue into an electrical apprenticeship, your certificate will count towards your qualification.

Career Opportunities

After successfully completing this certificate, you will be a preferred candidate for an electrical apprenticeship.

Entry Requirements

You will need:

- To be aged 15 years or over
- To be currently completing a senior secondary program VCE or VCE VM
- To spend at least one day per school week on timetabled training
- Sufficient communication, literacy and numeracy skills

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) and Credit Transfer

If you have skills or knowledge gained through previous study or relevant experience, you may be eligible for Recognition of Prior Learning and/ or Credit Transfer.

This would reduce the amount of training needed to complete the course, and will be discussed with you during the pre-training review.
