The Certificate III in Sport & Recreation is offered by Drouin Secondary College in partnership via auspicing agreement with registered training organization: SAVILE Training, RTO Number: 45452.

About the Course:

The Sport and Recreation program provides students the opportunity to acquire and develop the skills, knowledge and confidence to work in the areas of community and outdoor recreation. Leadership, organizational and specialist activity skills will be developed through theory and practical sessions. The second year of the course is also a scored unit 3 & 4 subject.

Program Length: 2 years - Commencement of program will depend on adequate numbers for enrolment
