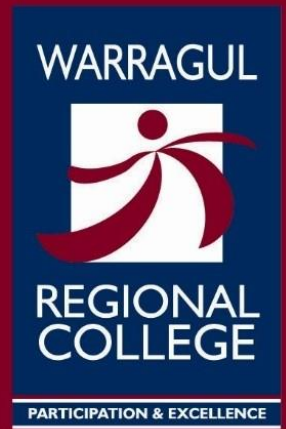


Warragul Regional College Laptop Ordering Information



Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Program

Warragul Regional College operates a BYOD program. Parents/carers are encouraged to provide a suitable device for their child to use at school.

We have partnered with **Learning with Technologies (LWT)**, and **edunet** offering dedicated online ordering portals (linked on the WRC website and below). Alternatively, you may purchase a device from any retailer, provided it meets our minimum specifications.

Ordering a Device

Please follow these steps to order a device for the upcoming school year:

1. Visit:

1. Select a device, insurance, and accessories.
2. Enter your details.
3. Choose a payment method and complete your order.

Devices ordered through official portals are delivered to the school, set up by the I.T. Department, and ready on Day 1.

Retail purchases (e.g., Harvey Norman) must be booked for setup via the WRC I.T. Department.

Important Notes

- Insurance sales are deferred for **5 days** after purchase by law.
- **Priority setup** is given to devices ordered via the official portals.

Minimum System Requirements

- **Processor:** Dual Core 1.5GHz
- **Memory:** 8GB RAM
- **Battery:** 6 hours minimum
- **Storage:** 256GB
- **Wi-Fi:** 802.11 g/n/ac
- **OS:** Windows 11 Pro/Edu or Mac OS

Note: Chromebooks and tablets are not supported.

Extended Warranty

Student laptops endure heavy daily use. Extended warranties are highly recommended—especially for the 2nd and 3rd years—to cover breakdowns (not user damage).

All portal-ordered devices include a **3-year warranty**.

Accidental Damage Insurance

Accidents happen—even with care. Insurance helps minimise repair costs, which can be significant. Though optional, it's **strongly recommended**.

The school processes **50+ accidental damage claims annually**.

Note: A separate invoice for insurance is issued **five days after** purchase.
