Year 10 Multi-Industry Pathway Program

AGA's Year 10 Multi-Industry Pathway Program offers eligible secondary school students a unique opportunity to gain hands-on experience across various trades. This 6-month program is designed to help students understand what working in different trades entails, develop essential skills, and discover their strengths.

By participating in a hands-on construction project, students will navigate the stages of a construction job, gaining practical experience while building key competencies such as:

- Teamwork and collaboration
- Work Health and Safety (WHS) practices
- Estimation and technical trade skills

Throughout the program, students will explore different industries in detail, including overviews of Certificate II pre-apprenticeships and potential future roles for fully qualified tradespeople.

This experience enables students to make informed decisions about their year 11 and 12 program choices and potential future career paths.
